Percussion is currently scheduled for a specialized camp from Monday August 10th through Friday August14th. Please be prepared to attend. All percussion must be present for this week. Marching Band Camp is Monday August 17th through Friday August 28th at McNary. Marching Band Camp is required for **all** students who are performing on the field. August 17th is only for Freshman and leadership students. The full camp begins on August 18th. Hours for camp will be from 9:00am -5:00pm.

We will have our first performance on Friday August 28^{th} at McNary from 6:00 pm -8:00 pm. There will be a BBQ provided by the boosters for immediate families and our performance starts at 6:45. The band will also perform at the annual Blue Day, Saturday August 29^{th} (times to be determined.) All of our rehearsals and performances are required. If you have a conflict please speak with me as soon as you know. August 17^{th} and 18^{th} are very full days so please make sure you are already registered and bring **all** payments and paperwork in at 8:00 am.

Taking Care of Business Day: Hours your student can participate are: 8:00am-9:00 am and 5:00pm-7:30pm on Thursday August 20th.

Band Day: This event is on Saturday September 12th. This is the biggest money raising project we have. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 or more on this day. **EVERY MEMBER OF THE BAND IS** REQUIRED AND NEEDED TO PARTICIPATE!!!!!! The day usually goes from 8:00am to 6:00pm. I ask that Band parents make themselves available to help drive, count donations, provide your home for students to come by for a snack, or any other needs the band has that day. If you are only able to help on one day this year, please make this your priority.

Sectionals: Each section of the band will have a sectional after school at lest once per week. The times will be decided by the section leaders. Please come prepared to band camp ready to give input as to what days work best.

Game Days: September 18th, October 2nd, October 16th, October 30th Senior Night. On game day you will need to be in the band room at 5:00 p.m. We will stay until the end of the game. Play-in games are in the month of November if the team makes it into the playoffs. There is a Thursday music practice the day before the game from 2:30-4:00. This will include all band members in the program that are not on the Varsity football field.

Outline of fees:

Band fees: \$225.00

Marching shoes: \$35.00 (new shoes)

Apparel fee: \$50.00

Fair Share Fees: Band fees for the year will be \$225.00. This pays for the whole year, as we provide some meals, pay for buses, and pay for some of the equipment the band needs during the year. Please pay this during camp, or make arrangements with the booster group to do a monthly payment. Check with me if you need financial help, and I will guide you to the scholarship form. We can also make payment arrangements. Do not let the fees keep you out of band!

Apparel: \$50.00 due at registration. You will get a McNary Athletic Band Jacket and 1 band shirt. Additional shirts are available to purchase. Your band shirt is part of your uniform. You will wear it under your uniform, at pep assemblies, and other events. If you are a freshman you will need marching shoes, we will order them for you, and there is a 35.00 fee for these shoes due at Registration.

Concert Dress: Ladies will wear a black dress that is provided by the school. They will need to have black flat dress shoes AND will need to have a hemming party in order to get all the dresses hemmed in time for performance. Men—you will wear a black tux for concerts. You will need a white tuxedo shirt, black bow tie, black dress shoes and black socks.

Instrument Rental: Marching band instrument only fee: \$20.00. Full year instrument use: \$50.00. Instrument use for any other ensemble is \$25.00 per semester. These fees will be used to repair and maintain the instrument your child uses. This fee is required at time of check out. The check must be written to Salem Keizer School District with your child's student number on the hottom. Fees: Due at check out of instrument.
